

Suzano Pulp and Paper Announces new Head of Pulp Business Unit

São Paulo, December 4th, 2008. Suzano Papel e Celulose – (Bovespa: SUZB5), announces that, during the meeting held on this date, the Board of Directors elected Alexandre Yambanis Head of Pulp Business Unit, who will take office as from January 26th, 2009.
